Information

Intended Audience:

Cardiologists, registered nurses, clinical nurse specialists, practice managers, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, pharmacists, and individuals interested in training for careers in cardiovascular medicine.

Purpose:

- There is a growing population of adult patients with congenital heart disease. Adult cardiologists and cardiac care associates in practice frequently are not equipped to manage these complex patients. This meeting will provide an update on essential knowledge needed to provide appropriate care.
- Healthcare reform is forcing cardiologists and healthcare systems to measure, evaluate and improve the quality of care provided. This meeting will update members on resources the ACC has to assist in these efforts.
- Recent advances in cardiac stents and newly approved medications make post implantation management more complicated. This program will help providers improve their clinical decision making in the use of these therapies.

Educational Objectives:

- Outline the two approaches for the TAVI (Transcatheter Aortic Valve implantation).
- Identify how my practice can demonstrate value.
- Describe the safety and efficacy of dual anti-platelet therapy in recipient of coronary drug eluting stents.
- Describe the common complications experienced by patients with congenital heart disease.
